*The BA degree has a language requirement. It can be satisfied by any one of the following:

- a. Language 401-402 (two semesters of elementary level)
- b. Language 403 (one semester review) plus 503 for those with two or more years of prior study.
- c. Language 503 (intermediate).
- d. By scoring a 4 or 5 on the Advanced Placement (AP) test, you may be exempted.

If you use option c or d more elective credits are needed to graduate.

Music requirements must receive grade of C- or better.

A student not enrolled in private lessons participates in a symposium instead.

***Any combination of lessons and ensembles for a total of 8 credits fulfills the requirement. This can be achieved in any timeframe within the four years. A maximum of 8 credits earned in ensembles may be used toward graduation.**

4 writing intensive courses are required by the University. One must be English 401 and one must be in your major. The "700 level" music history course fulfills the upper level 'WI' requirement and the 'WI' course in your major requirement. Two more WI courses are then needed.
