

# UNH Granada Program

## Courses at the Centro de Lenguas Modernas

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Prior to departure, you will complete a course approval form to indicate your initial course preferences and obtain official UNH course equivalency approvals
- Upon arrival, you will take a comprehensive placement exam to confirm your track and then register for courses
- Depending on your track you may have a mandatory language class (see below). You then choose either **4 or 5 courses** for a total of 5 classes (20 UNH credits).
- Courses take place Monday through Thursday with occasional Friday meeting obligations
- You can count up to 2 courses towards both the Spanish major and Discovery credit
- Students who enroll in coursework that significantly repeats coursework taken at UNH may not receive credit
- Studying abroad in Granada fulfills the World Cultures (WC) Discovery requirement
- Courses count as transfer credit. This means that 1) you must attain at least a C to obtain credit, and 2) although your grade will appear on your transcript it will not affect your UNH GPA
