The Political Science minor consists of five courses (20 credits). Any combination of five courses is acceptable. However, you cannot take more than two 400 level introductory courses. You may concentrate on one field, or you may choose to diversify your minor. The areas you may choose from are:

International Politics

Up to two courses in your **minor** can also count towards General Education Requirements (this **cannot** be done with major/Gen. Eds.). Keep in mind that you can only "double count" a total of two courses (eight credits) throughout your academic career.
