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A minor in Spanish is a very useful complement to majors in many other disciplines such as **social service, nursing, teaching, business, hotel administration**, etc. The Spanish Minor program allows students to develop their language proficiency and knowledge of Spanish culture, while also concentrating on other fields of study. Students who would like to minor in Spanish must follow the guidelines below. during Your final semester please fill out the Completion of Minor form. Members of the department supervise both the Spanish major and minor programs.

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## REQUIREMENTS

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- A minimum of 20 credits 503 and above (typically 5 courses)
    - Must include SPAN 631 or SPAN 632
  - Only ONE course in English may be applied to the minor (SPAN 525 or 526)
- 2 TRANSFER COURSES MAXIMUM ( AP or Study Abroad credit)
- A grade of C- or better and a 2.00 grade point average in courses that the minor department approves.. Courses taken on Pass/Fail basis may not be used for a minor.
    - No more than 8 credits used by a student to satisfy major requirements may be used for the minor.
