**WHO CAN APPLY?** Only string players who are members of the UNH-YSO may apply. Applicants must be UNH-YSO musicians in good standing for both the fall and spring semesters. Concertos with multiple solos (e.g., Bach Double Violin Concerto) are welcome to apply.

**LIMITATIONS:** Your concerto accompaniment must exist in a form for string orchestra and cannot exceed 10 minutes in duration. Dr. Upham can provide assistance as needed.
