



Youth Drama Option (B.A.)

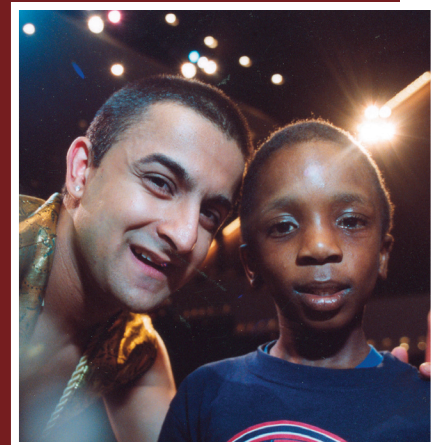
