HOW TO APPLY

Please submit the following materials to Avary Thorne (Avary.Thorne@unh.edu) in a single application packet/pdf by **December 3rd, 2021**.

1. A 3-page (single-space) outline of your proposed activity, including the project's goals, scope, methodology, timeline, intended output, and expected impact; and a final paragraph contextualizing your expertise or motivation to accomplish the proposed activity. Individual student proposals will need to list a faculty supervisor.
2. A detailed budget for the proposed activity, including the specific amount you are requesting from GRSIL; a list of other UNH grants or potential funding you have access to; and a budget narrative explaining how the requested GRSIL funds will be spent.
