New Hampshire Teacher Education Scholarship

Overview

The College of Liberal Arts at the University of New Hampshire is pleased to offer tuition scholarships to **non-degree students** who are **full-time teachers or principals in K-12 New Hampshire schools**. Those who are awarded a scholarship will pay a tuition rate of \$450 per credit, up to a total of 12 credits (plus applicable fees) once the scholarship is applied. Eligible teachers may enroll in pertinent courses offered by the <u>College of Liberal Arts</u> (in education, languages, history, etc.) offered either online or in-person as part of the regular course schedule (fall, spring, summer and J-term).

Eligibility Requirements

- All applicants must currently hold a full-time position as a teacher or principal in a New Hampshire K-12 school. Paraprofessionals and other education professionals are currently not eligible.
- Applicants must not currently be enrolled in a UNH degree program and will enroll in courses using scholarship funds as a non-degree student.

Available Courses

- Approved applicants can enroll in any UNH (Durham) course offering from the College of Liberal Arts, subject to availability. Upcoming course schedules are updated throughout the year and are available online at https://courses.unh.edu/. The College of Liberal Arts offers courses in the departments/subjects listed here.
- Applicants are subject to any course-specific pre-requisite or registration permission requirements as noted in the course schedule posted online.

- Approved applicants can enroll in up to 12 credits with the scholarship. These 12 credits can be taken across multiple terms (as long as you continue to meet scholarship eligibility requirements).

How to Apply

- Complete the application form below and submit to NHTeacher.Scholarship@unh.edu no later than two weeks prior to the start of your intended course(s). We will review your application and let you know if you are approved by email.
- If approved, we will work to coordinate your registration and billing on your behalf. Do not register yourself for courses if you intend to apply for the scholarship.
- Please submit one application form per registration term. If you wish to take additional courses in the future using the scholarship (up to 12 credits), please submit a new application form at that time.
