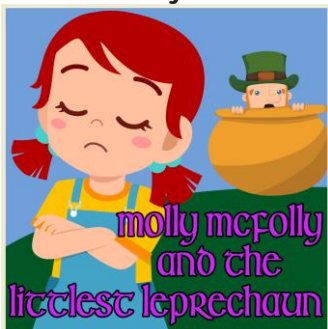

- **Compensation includes rehearsal fee (\$15/hr) and per show stipend.**
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*Rehearsals may start later than May 22. Exact start date will be set when offers are made.

PREPARE:

- 1. Tell a story no longer than two-minutes, that you would tell to an audience of children of various ages. Make it fun, physical, energetic and creative.
- 2. Sing a short amount of a song (about 16 bars), acapella. Just enough so we can hear your voice. This does not have to be geared for children. If you really do not consider yourself much of a singer- a rousing version of happy birthday is totally acceptable. Not all roles being cast need to sing.
- 3. The rest of the audition time will consist of improvisational exercises and work with the script.
- If you play the guitar or violin well enough to play relatively easy Irish Folk music, please bring your instrument to the audition.
- 4. Please bring your headshot and resume with you, in addition to filling out the on-line form.
- Be prepared to play with an Irish dialect. This does not have to be perfected, but we will need to see where you are with a bit of an Irish brogue!
