- c. Language 503 (intermediate)
- d. By scoring a 4 or 5 on the Advanced Placement (AP) exam, you may be exempt.

If you use option c or d, more elective credits will be needed to graduate.

Music requirements must receive grade of C- or better.

\*\* Any combination of lessons and ensembles fulfills the requirement. This can be achieved in any timeframe within the four years. A student not enrolled in private lessons will participate in a symposium instead.

A maximum of 8 credits earned in ensembles may be used toward graduation.
