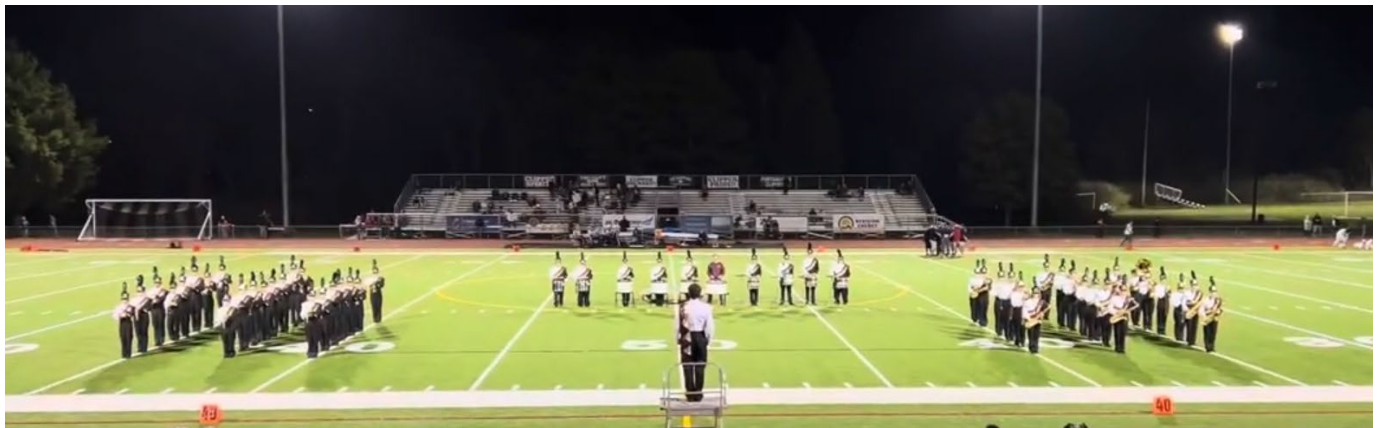

GOOGLE MAP FOR SHOW BUS/TRUCK/ADA DIRECTIONS FROM ROUTE 4

- Take exit for NH-155A Durham
- Turn south on NH-155A toward Durham/UNH
- At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit (right) and follow road down and around to Stadium Lot
- Someone will direct you where to park
- ADA spectators proceed to the lobby to purchase tickets and take elevator to concourse

SPECTATOR DIRECTIONS FROM ROUTE 4

- Take exit for NH-155A Durham
- Turn south on NH-155A toward Durham/UNH
- At the traffic circle, take the 3RD exit to North Drive (horse barn side)
- Either turn right on Sage Way or continue straight on North Dr.
- Lot A is the large lot in front of you at the end of either road
- After parking, walk toward Main St./Field House (brick building across the street) to the tunnel (see line on map).
- After emerging from tunnel near Field House, proceed right down the stairs and continue to Gate A under the video board.
