

**Approval Form
Senior Humanities Thesis**

A requirement for the Humanities major is a thesis that is completed during the senior year. In consultation with the Humanities Program thesis liaison, the major selects a faculty member to advise him/her in researching and writing the thesis over the two semesters of the senior year. The adviser (also called the "first reader") will meet with the student regularly to define the topic, monitor progress, and, in consultation with the other two thesis readers, decide on the grade (which is filed by the thesis liaison) at the end of each semester.

This approval form must be completed and signed by the student and the thesis faculty adviser. It should be submitted to the Humanities Program coordinator no later than the first week of October (see "thesis deadlines" on the Humanities Program website for the precise date: www.unh.edu/humanities-program).
